His responsibilities include conducting the University Wind Ensemble and Chamber Winds, teaching the graduate instrumental conducting sequence and coordinating all aspects of FAU's comprehensive university bands program. He holds undergraduate degrees from the University of Idaho, and the Master of Music and the Doctor of Musical Arts degrees in Wind Conducting from The University of Texas at Austin, where his principal conducting teacher was Jerry F. Junkin. Additionally, he has studied with exemplary conductors through fourteen international conducting symposia.

Prior to his work at The University of Texas, Dr. Prescott conducted bands and orchestras in the Pacific Northwest for eight years. Ensembles under his direction have been invited to perform at Conferences of the National Association for Music Education in 1997 and 1999, the Southern Conference of the College Band Directors National Association in 2008 and the Florida Music Educators Association Conference in 2009. His research in score analysis has been published in three volumes of the Teaching Music Through Performance series, and he is the current Florida State Chair of CBDNA, and Conductor and Music Director of South Florida's professional wind band, the Florida Wind Symphony.
