THOMAS F. FLEMING, JR. — among the numerous public spirited citizens who worked diligently to bring about the establishment of Florida Atlantic University, there is unanimous agreement that the breath of life was given by the determination and dedication of this one man. It was he who led in the negotiations to secure the land. It was he, again, who spearheaded the drive for contributions to make possible the scheduled opening in 1962. It was he who founded the Endowment Corporation, forerunner of the FAU Foundation which he still serves as Chairman and to which he has been a major contributor.

But his dedication and service encompasses all of higher education. During the past 20 years, he has often set aside his personal responsibilities to give leadership to programs benefiting all of higher education in Florida. He supported the concept of bond financing for construction of facilities at community colleges and state universities, and, in 1963, he served as Chairman of Citizens for Florida's Future, the lay group which successfully urged passage of a constitutional amendment to permit such financing. The massive construction which took place on campuses throughout the State during the last decade would not have been possible without this constitutional mandate. In a very real sense, this achievement alone earns for Mr. Fleming the title of "Mr. Education."

In 1963 the bank of which he was, and is, Chairman of the Board became the first financial institution in the nation to dedicate a percentage of its profits before taxes to education. Subsequently, the holding company he heads has adopted that same policy. He has given years of service to the Education Committees of the Council of 100 and of the State Chamber of Commerce.

A native of Georgia, Mr. Fleming was reared in South Florida, earned the bachelaureate degree at the University of Florida, and was awarded the Master's with distinction by the Harvard University Graduate School of Business.

He is a man who uses his broad knowledge and wide contacts in the furtherance of the public good. His activities bring honor to his State and to his adopted Alma Mater, Florida Atlantic University.

DONALD H. REED, JR. — attorney and lay leader, achieved during his years of service in the Florida Legislature a reputation for excellence which transcended any partisanship. He rose quickly to become Minority Leader in the House of Representatives, and through his effectiveness contributed to the development of a viable two-party system in the State. Nonetheless, his concerns as a State Legislator were not influenced by party lines but by the welfare of Florida and of his constituents.

He was an indispensable participant in the development of a new constitution for the State and was a prime force in developing bi-partisan support for the highly controversial but essential reorganization of the executive branch of State government. His contributions have been recognized in effecting judicial reform, land use control legislation, and in other areas of critical concern to the management of growth in Florida.

During his legislative tenure, he was active in educational reform, a guardian of academic freedom, and aggressive in his support of Florida Atlantic University. He led a struggle over several years to bring about equal funding for similar programs in all universities in the State University System, thus improving financial support for programs not only at Florida Atlantic, but at each of the new state institutions in the System.

It was Don Reed's decisive leadership that brought about legislative authorization for the College of Engineering at Florida Atlantic University, a program which is meeting significant needs in this area and which might have been delayed by many years without his strong support.

Mr. Reed was born and raised in Ohio. He was graduated from Ohio State University, and after military service, enrolled in the University of Florida School of Law where he earned the Juris Doctor degree.

Although he has retired from the Legislature, Mr. Reed continues his active interest in Florida Atlantic University. He serves on the Board of Directors of the Florida Atlantic University Foundation, Inc., on the Environmental Land Management Study Committee and as Chairman of the State Officers' Compensation Commission. He is truly a man who brings enthusiasm to the causes he espouses and whose service marks him for a significant place in the history of Florida's progress.

ARNOLD W. JOHNSON — practicing accountant, author, and teacher, has made enduring contributions to his profession and to the institutions at which he has served throughout a long and distinguished career.

A native of New York, he received a B.B.A. from the University of Washington and an M.B.A. from the Harvard University Graduate School.

While Professor Johnson has spent most of his life in teaching, he also served in the business field. He began his teaching career as Assistant Professor of Accounting at West Virginia University and subsequently served on the faculties of several other institutions. In 1954 he was named Professor of Accounting and Department Chairman at New York University where he remained until his retirement in 1966. At that time, he was named Professor of Accounting, *emeritus*.

Professor Johnson has written thirteen textbooks relating to accounting. He served on many prestigious committees in the American Accounting Association and became its Vice-President in 1956-57.

From 1966-68 he served as Visiting Professor of Accounting at the University of Florida. In 1968, he came to Florida Atlantic University as Visiting Professor of Accounting and he has continued to teach here without salary until his retirement in June, 1974.

During his tenure here he has won the respect of both faculty and students. His standards have served as a model to all. He has done much to enhance the quality and reputation of the accounting program at Florida Atlantic University and has won the esteem and respect of the local accounting profession through his service to its varied activities.

His life and his generous giving of his time and talent to Florida Atlantic University provide an example for all to emulate.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Lending color to the pageantry of the Academic Convocation are the academic robes and hoods worn by the faculty. This regalia reaches back into the medieval ages when it served a functional as well as an ornamental role, separating the learned men from other groups and offering warmth and protection.

In America in the late nineteenth century, a conference was held by representatives of colleges and universities to bring some more order and system to the custom of academic dress. Since then, there have been periodic conferences to revise or reconfirm existing practices.

Essentially, holders of the bachelor's degree wear black robes unadorned. Holders of the master's degrees wear hoods which are lined with the colors of the college conferring the degree and trimmed with the color representing the subject in which the degree was earned. The doctoral robe is adorned with velvet and is also worn with the hood suitably ornamented.

Holders of degrees from foreign universities or religious orders wear the entire academic costume as decreed by the conferring institution.
