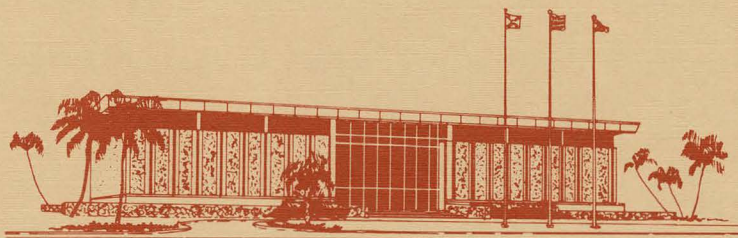

MARJORIE DAVIS CRICK was born in Kansas and moved with her family to Delray Beach in 1914. She attended local schools and was graduated from Florida State College for Women in Tallahassee with an L.I. degree in 1924 and started on her long and distinguished career of service to education in Florida. She earned the Bachelor of Science degree from Florida Southern College in 1941 and the Master of Education from the University of Miami in 1947.

After some years of teaching at the elementary and junior high school levels, Mrs. Crick was asked to organize a program for exceptional students for the Palm Beach County School Board. The program that was started in 1941 by Mrs. Crick in one room, with one teacher and seven pupils, had grown to serve over 10,000 students and had a staff of 300 teachers, plus support personnel, by the time of her retirement in 1974 as Director of Exceptional Child Education for the County.

During her thirty-year commitment to the cause of providing the best possible education for exceptional children, Mrs. Crick has organized and served on numerous professional and advisory committees and has been called upon as a consultant to set up similar programs throughout the United States and the world. She was on the adjunct faculty at Florida Atlantic University and was a guest professor at George Peabody College. The State Department of Education and Florida Atlantic University jointly honored her at a conference on troubled youth in 1972.

In recognition of her pioneering work in Palm Beach County on behalf of exceptional children and for her many years of service to education, Florida Atlantic University is pleased to confer on Marjorie Davis Crick the honorary degree, Doctor of Humane Letters.

AVERY H. FONDA has had a long and successful career as a banker and businessman, but it is for his lifetime of civic involvement and commitment that we honor him here today.

A 1944 Phi Beta Kappa graduate of the University of North Carolina in Chapel Hill, Mr. Fonda has served as chief executive officer and on the board of a number of banks in the south and northeast. While climbing the ladder of success in his chosen profession, he has also donated his time and talents to numerous community organizations like the United Way, chambers of commerce, educational institutions, and economic development councils, to name a few. Since he moved to Boca Raton in 1976, no fewer than 14 community organizations have benefited from his advice and assistance.

Mr. Fonda founded and served as chairman of the Ad Hoc Committee for Higher Education in Southeast Florida during 1983-84, the year in which the greatest strides were made in expanding higher education opportunities for this region through successful legislative lobbying for funding the Southeast Florida Plan.

In 1982 Florida Atlantic University bestowed on him its Distinguished Service Award in recognition of his support and commitment to establishing higher education opportunities for the citizens of our area. At this time, the University is pleased to acknowledge his additional efforts and support by bestowing on Avery H. Fonda the honorary degree, Doctor of Humane Letters.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Lending color to the pageantry of the Academic Convocation are the robes and hoods worn by the faculty. This regalia reaches back into the medieval ages when it served a functional as well as ornamental role.

In the late nineteenth century, a conference was held by representatives of American colleges and universities to systemize academic dress. Since then, there have been periodic conferences to revise or reconfirm existing practices.

Essentially, holders of the bachelor's degree wear black robes unadorned. Holders of the master's degree wear hoods which are lined with the colors of the college conferring the degree and trimmed with the color representing the subject in which the degree was earned.

The following list reflects the colors which will be found on the hoods worn in the Academic Procession at this Convocation, and the subject each represents.
